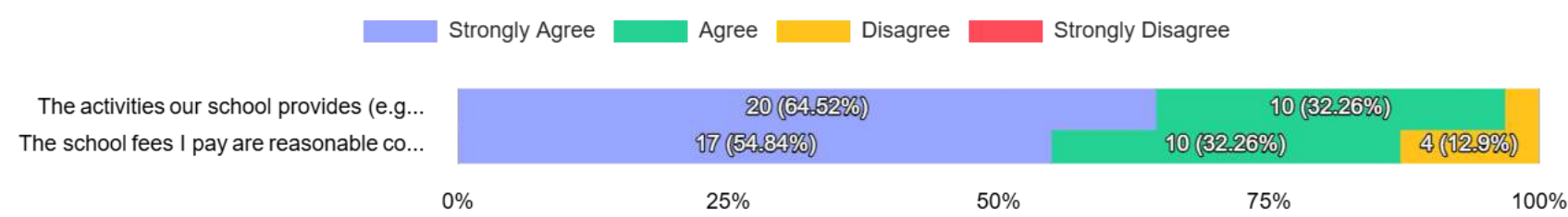

I don't find some of the speakers are beneficial to my child's learning. While they may be fun, and the kids enjoy them, I don't think us paying for the Opera for example is something that is worth it. Especially because the performance times are always during school hours. So, as a working parent, my child performs and I am unable to see it. And I can't take the time off, because I need to pay for the performance group. I would love to see more clubs within the school. The field trips are lacking, and I think that there should be more of them at the school. 75% goes to salaries, and the other 25% to my child? That seems like a lot. Especially since I am always paying some sort of fee for something for my child to take part in.

I would be ok with paying more fees for special activities (grade 6 Farewell, field trips, activities , residencies etc) if it meant there was less fundraising.

This is our very first year 'Kindergarten' in the school system and I have never had issues with communication/information regarding any extra cost. We as parents have all the information that we need to make a decision on time, actually well in advance way before a field trip is due etc. Thank you so much for sharing all these information on time!!!

I strongly believe that learning can happen outside the classroom. I support more field trips, even if it means an increase in fees. Transportation fees are not prorated for children who only ride once a day. Lunch supervision fee doesn't seem to cover childrens wellbeing during lunch period. It seems to be a free play time where children can choose to eat or not; and in my son's case...most often not. He comes home unfed and overstimulated.
